The Mayor Report stated \$93.31 was received from the District Magistrate and \$303.99 from State Police fines for a total of \$4397.30. The Tax Collectors Report was given for \$13,176.72.

Ron Umholtz presented his code enforcement report. He stated citations were filed for Sourwine and 309 E. Market Street. Eviction is still scheduled for 211 Tunnel Street. Bill Miller stated he has placed warning notices on several vehicles. Bill questioned Koppy's billing; statements will be reviewed. Dane informed Bill there are a few Christmas lights out and that the lights can be taken down mid-January when we have a nice day. No additional applications for the road job have been received to date but it was stated Bill is doing a great job and we will continue to run the ad. It was stated all the new cameras are up and running; a few adjustments are being done but they are doing the job.

Solicitor Kerwin reported he is still finalizing the purchase of the 2nd Market Street building and still hopes demolition of both can be done at the same time.

A motion was made by Brian Troup to approve the resolution for PMRS acknowledging the 3% minimum contribution rate. Steve Denkovich 2nd the motion and all were in favor.

Brian Troup made a motion to pay bills for \$10.022.27 and payroll for \$4530.77. Ron Umholtz 2^{nd} the motion and all were in favor. Steve Denkovich made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Donald Machamer 2^{nd} the motion and all were in favor.
