

## **Williamstown Borough Meeting Minutes August 2, 2021**

Williamstown Borough Council met Monday, August 2, 2021 in Council Chambers. Present were: President Dane Williard, Mark Challenger, Jr., Brian Troup, Steve Denkovich, Donald Machamer, Solicitor Joe Kerwin, Mayor Jeffrey Shuttlesworth and Road Supervisor, Bill Miller. Absent was Secretary Lynne Daniel and Vice President, Ronald Umholtz

Minutes from the July 12<sup>th</sup> meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

Penny Bush and Linda Lewis were present representing the Historical Society. They presented Council with a letter of thanks for all the work completed recently at the Historical Society by the Borough and its' employees.

The Mayors report was given with \$80.06 from the District Justice. The Road Supervisors report was reviewed and Bill stated New Enterprise would be up to mark the roads on Tuesday. The John Deere mower that broke was discussed. County Turf and Trail gave a price on a trade in for a new zero turn mower for \$5,922.00. Brian Troup made a motion to purchase; Steve Denkovich 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor.

Solicitor Kerwin stated he is still waiting on a firm date from the County for the demolition of the 2 buildings. He does believe it will be in the next 2 months. The Berger resident on W. Market was discussed and could have possibly been foreclosed on.

The new Stoney Park sign was discussed and an estimate from Kasper Construction was submitted. The sign cost was \$475.00 and installation was \$2,490.00. The Williamstown Legion agreed to pay half of the cost. The possibility of the Borough installing the sign was discussed as an option. Steve Denkovich made a motion to move forward with the purchase and installation done by Kasper Construction. Brian Troup 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor.

The purchase of a 34' Boom Lift through ARPA monies was discussed. The estimate is for \$57,700.00. Brian Troup made a motion to purchase; Mark Challenger, Jr. 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor.

A motion was made to pay payroll for \$7,109.74 and bills for \$14,307.33 by Brian Troup. Steve Denkovich 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor. A motion was made by Steve Dankovich to adjourn the meeting. Brian Troup 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion and all were in favor.
