## Williamstown Borough Meeting Minutes May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022

Williamstown Borough Council met Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 at 7:30 PM in Council Chambers. Present were: President Dane Williard, Brian Troup, Donald Machamer, Mayor Jeffrey Shuttleswoth, Road Supervisor Bill Miller and Secretary Rikki Merwine. Absent was Vice President Ron Umholtz, Stephen Denkovich, and Solicitor Joe Kerwin.

Citizens Present: Rosemary Hoke, Jack Flynn, Shayna Machamer.

The pledge of allegiance to the flag was recited. Minutes from the April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

Jack Flynn Jr. represented the Williamstown American Legion to thank the Borough for the support of grants that the legion received to help remodel bathrooms. Jack reported that since 2015, the legion has received approximately 170 thousand dollars thanks to the Borough's help. Jack Flynn reported that he met with Kenny Drum and they will develop a game plan to start work on the properties across from legion that were demolished. Jack stated that the legion will wait to take ownership of the properties until they figure out the details of turning it into a parking lot.

President Dane Williard told Jack Flynn that there is a wall pushing in toward the Historical Society and asked for permission to dig on the legion side, if needed, to stop from caving in. Jack Flynn Jr. gave his OK.

The Mayor's report was given with \$212.99 received from the District Justice. The Tax Collector's report was given. We received \$9,553.96 in Real Estate tax, \$947.49 in Street Light tax, \$3,104.30 in Occupation tax, and \$133.40 in Per Capita tax for the month of April.

There was no code enforcement report for the May meeting.

The Road supervisor report was reviewed. Donald Machamer questioned what we do for cars that do not move during street sweeping. Bill- we ticket and tow if needed.

The lyft should be here this month. Rikki will get an AD ready for bids for the 2010 truck.

There was illegal dumping at the brush pile. The cameras will be looked at to see if we can see who it is.

Brian Troup motioned to pay the bills and payroll for \$12,748.18. Donald Machamer 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor.
